Learn to Ride (Age 8-100) Private Lessons

Sambea lessons are focused on improving your horsemanship skills in a fun & safe learning environment. Please arrive twenty minutes early to prepare your horse before your scheduled lesson time. Please record your, and your one spectator's arrival and departure time into our lesson log. For bio-security reasons you must bring your own grooming tote with the following brushes: hoof pick, rubber circular curry comb, hand towel, hoof oil, glycerine soap and sponge, dandy brush, body brush and mane comb. Your private riding lesson will be approximately 45-50 minutes. Please bring a carrot or apple for your horse to reward him/her after your ride. After your lesson, please help untack your horse and groom him/her.

Lesson payment options:

- 1) Issue Sambea Farm twelve post-dated cheques for the months January -December (\$280 per month). Please issue these cheques to Sambea Farm and place these cheques in the wooden lock box inside the tack room.
- 2) E-transfers are accepted on a term basis (3 months at time, \$840).
